

CALL TO ARTISTS

About us: Krewe des Fleurs, formed in 2014, is a costume and performance collaborative. Each year we build large-format costumes in the likeness of one flower varietal. Throughout the year we march in major Mardi Gras & holiday parades and appear at community events.

The costume is designed by a local artist who sketches, **builds a prototype and then guides our members through a series of workshops to recreate the prototype.** Our members are each responsible for building their own flower under the direct guidance of the artist.

Opportunity: Krewe des Fleurs seeks proposals from local costume designers, artists, etc., interested in creating the design for our 2020 costume, which will be debuted on 12th Night. (Our costume and flower varietal and concept are kept in strict confidence between the krewe and the artist until the debut.)

In addition to the financial incentive, we offer marketing opportunities through our social media channels, and website. The artist is also invited to parade with us throughout the 2019-2020 season in the prototype they create, or another appropriately themed garden creature costume of their choosing (e.g., bugs, butterfly, sun, etc.)
